

TERMS & CONDITIONS

The Emerging Growth Conference is owned and controlled by Global Discovery Group, Inc. (“GDG” or the “Host”) GDG is in the business of providing a service in the form of a Platform (the “Platform”) for companies and individuals (the “Presenter(s)”, or the “Company”) to speak to an audience (the “Attendees”) who may or may not be aware of the Presenter’s Company, product, or service (the “Presentation”). The Platform is called the Emerging Growth Conference (“The Conference”). GDG can also provide a page on EmergingGrowth.com which can host data for the Presenters (the Company Page) and send updates to Attendees of the Presenters. This service is called Emerging Growth Plus. CDG also provides Emerging Growth Research for the Companies that present at Emerging Growth Conferences. This research is Company Sponsored Research (“CSR”) and its terms and conditions are described following the terms and conditions of the Emerging Growth Conference and Emerging Growth Plus.

Emerging Growth Conference and Emerging Growth Plus Terms & Conditions

1. Upon the terms and subject to the conditions within (the “Terms”, as detailed in the Invoice above, the Presenter hereby retains GDG to provide the Platform in the form of the Emerging Growth Conference for it to give a Presentation to Attendees at a specific date and time detailed in the invoice to the Presenter and / or host a Company page for the Company. The Company acknowledges that GDG shall have the right to (a) engage third parties to assist it in its efforts to provide the Platform and / or the Company Page and (b) provide and / or continue to provide the Platform and / or the Company Page to entities other than the Presenter, some of which may engage or may become engaged in operations similar to those of the Presenter and notwithstanding these terms, the Presenter acknowledges that GDG shall be free to render services of any kind to any other entity at any time.
2. The services provided by GDG regarding the Conference are:
 - a. Allow the Presenter to present on the Emerging Growth Conference as follows (the “Presentation(s)”):
 - i. Number of presentations: 1 or more as detailed in the invoice.
 - ii. Duration of presentation: 30 minutes for a Full Spot, 10 - 12 minutes for an Update Spot.
 - b. Provide the Presenter with a unique registration link (the “Link”) to include in a press release, or to otherwise release or distribute, for the purpose of announcing their attendance on each Emerging Growth Conference.
 - i. A draft press release is attached to the end of these Terms and can be altered in any way so long as the date and time of Presentation and the Link are accurate.
 - ii. Attendees can register to view each Presenter’s Conference, and provide their name, email address and phone number. (the “Attendee Data”)
 - iii. The Unique link will be different for each Presenter presenting on a Conference and each Conference a Presenter presents on.
 - iv. GDG only will share the Attendee Data with a Presenter if that Attendee registered under the respective Link for that Presenter. If an Attendee views a Presenter’s Conference by any means other than registering under that Presenters respective Link, that data will not be shared or given to that Presenter.
 - v. If the Presenter does not release news, or otherwise distribute their attendance containing the Link, no attendance data will be shared by the Host. The Presenter is required to alert GDG of its news release or other distribution of the Link via email containing a hyperlink to the news release, social media posts, or other distribution containing the Link.
 - c. Question & Answer (Q&A) after your initial presentation, the Presenter can either:
 - i. Submit questions to be asked after your Presentation by the Host.
 - ii. Take questions from the Attendees.
 - iii. A Combination of both (i and ii)
 - iv. Any questions you provide must be received by 5:00 PM EST the day before the Conference.
 - d. Time, Questions, Attendees
 - i. The Presenter may use any or all their time on their Presentation and allow no time for Q&A.
 - ii. Attendees to the event may or may not submit any questions for the Presenter.
 - iii. There are no representations made or guarantee to the number of Attendees on any Presentation.
 - iv. If a Presenter is late for their time slot, or by no fault of GDG, the Presenters Presentation begins late, their Presentation will still end at its scheduled ending time.
3. Responsibilities of the Presenter regarding the Conference:
 - a. Presenter can share media such as a presentation or video (the Media) The Media must be in either ppt, or .mp4 formats only (Maximum mp4 file size 10gb). Presenter must provide the Media to GDG no later than 5:00 PM EST on the Tuesday immediately before the Conference. Edits to the Media after that point can be made but are not guaranteed.
 - b. All mp4 files embedded within a PowerPoint presentation must be removed from the Power Point and sent to Host as separate mp4 files or links to download the separate mp4 files. Note the intended slide in the mp4 filename. All files which may be too large to email can be uploaded here: <https://www.dropbox.com/request/UsvCJoyofu0VSV8dNPiF>
 - c. Be available for a “Dry” (practice) Run.
 - i. Our staff will schedule a conference dry run on or before the Tuesday immediately before the Conference to assist you in accessing the platform, test your audio / video, ensure you can navigate your slides & videos, and answer any last-minute question you may have.
 - d. Provide an Introduction:
 - i. Presenters can prepare a custom introduction of which must be provided to GDG no later than 5:00 PM EST the Tuesday immediately before the Conference.

- e. Login to the Platform 15 minutes early.
 - i. Presenters will be given a different username and password for the live event than was given for the dry run. Presenters must log into the live event with the correct credentials at least 15 minutes early.
 - ii. Hard wired internet connection is strongly recommended. GDG is not responsible and there will not be a refund given if you internet connection is not sufficient, unstable, or for any reason affects the quality or outcome in any way of your Presentation.
 - iii. Presenters must close all other applications prior to and during the dry run and Presentation and turn off all VPN's.
- f. Presenters must be available within thirty minutes on either side of your presentation start time.
 - i. It is rare, but on occasion, we may have to, and we reserve the right to move your presentation time up to thirty minutes before or after your scheduled start time.
- g. Presenters must not be viewing the Conference at the time they are presenting. This action will cause feedback and interrupt the presentation.
- h. Be sure to read and understand the "What you need to know" document that is included in the original welcome email and reach out to us if you do not understand anything in it, or if you have any questions.
- i. Presenter will be available to present on the Conference at the time assigned. You also acknowledge and agree that the time of your presentation is subject to change, and if it does, you will present at that new time. Please keep a flexible schedule on the day you are to Present, because if you are unable to present for any reason, your payment will be forfeited.
- j. Presenter understands that schedules change due to issues beyond the control of GDG. If you would like to and are subsequently scheduled to present near or next to a specific Presenter, you realize and agree that the presentation date and time of all any or all Presenters may change due to circumstances on the Presenters part, which is not under the control of GDG. The Companies that you are scheduled to present next to or close to may change at any time.
- k. Emerging Growth will release press of your attendance on the Conference. It will be limited to the Company name, stock symbol of the Company, name of the Presenter, and the time of the presentation.

4. If you have elected to use the Emerging Growth Plus (follow up to all attendees and unlimited conference update spots) services:
 - a. GDG will set up a page on EmergingGrowth.com for your Company (the "Company Page").
 - i. The URL will be EmergingGrowth.com/Profile/[your (US Market) stock symbol]
 - ii. Company may publish on its Company page data including Decks, Reports, Presentations, Videos, etc. (The "Content")
 - iii. If the Company's stock does not trade on a US exchange, GDG may not be able to provide a Company Page.
 - b. The Company is responsible for supplying to GDG a high definition, preferably clear background corporate logo in .png form, and all Content that it would like published on its Company Page.
 - c. GDG will add an input form by where anybody can sign up to receive more updates on the Company.
 - d. GDG will email updates of the Company to the Attendees of the Company's Conference(s) for a period of 3 months. (the "Updates")
 - i. Updates include press releases, new corporate videos, new investor decks, etc. GDG will use its discretion and may choose not to email updates that include but are not limited to advertisements of products or attendance at other competing conferences or other events.
 - e. The Company will be permitted to return to the Conference up to two, (2) times for 10–12-minute update spots on the two Conferences immediately following the Company's first Presentation. (the "Update Spots") For example, if the Company gave a full presentation in December, it may use one Update Spot on each of the January and February Conferences. To be guaranteed an Update Spot on a future Conference, you must notify us by email no later than the Friday following the previous Conference.
 - f. The Presenter understands that the Update Spots are based on time availability, and it is recommended that these spots be reserved early. Only one Update Spot can be reserved at a time and must be reserved after the completion of the previous Conference, for the next upcoming Conference. Update spots cannot be reserved for a Conference that is scheduled after the next upcoming Conference.
 - g. It is the responsibility of the Company to alert GDG of any Updates via email sent to News@EmergingGrowth.com.
 - h. It is the responsibility of the Company to notify GDG that it wishes to use an Update Spot.
5. It is acknowledged and agreed by the Presenter that Host carries no professional licenses, and is not rendering legal advice, or performing consulting services. It is the sole responsibility of the Presenter to verify the accuracy and truthfulness of all content utilized in its Presentation and to consult with its legal and accounting professionals, before proceeding with any Presentation.
6. Once a date and time is reserved for a Presentation, and / or a Company Page is added to EmergingGrowth.com for the Presenter, all fees associated with such as detailed in the invoice (above), are due on the date specified on the Invoice, fully earned and non-refundable. If the Invoice is not paid timely, the presentation time may be changed. If a Presenter cancels its Presentation, it forfeits all fees for that respective Presentation. It is at the sole discretion of GDG, that its fees may be used for a future Conference, and because spots on each conference are limited and GDG may not be able to fill the spot of the Presenter which canceled its Presentation, there may be an additional fee required to move to a future Conference.

7. Presenters have the option to pre-record their Presentations and / or any other media for an additional fee (the "Pre-Recording"). If the Pre-Recording is cancelled for any reason, there will be a \$500.00 charge to re-schedule the Pre-Recording each time it is rescheduled.
8. Any cost associated with any collection of any unpaid funds, including any balance due to GDG by the Presenter, including but not limited to legal fees, arbitration fees, and any debt collection costs and fees, shall be added to the amount owed to GDG. If payment is not made prior to any service rendered, and services are rendered, the Presenter shall be responsible for a 50% charge for non-payment and all the costs associated with collection of the funds including but not limited to legal fees, arbitration fees, and any debt collection costs and fees.
9. If there is a payment schedule or plan associated, as detailed in the invoice above, it is the responsibility of the Company to make any payments due timely, when they are due. It is not the responsibility of GDG to bill or remind the Client for or of any payments due. In the event of late payment, or non-payment of any payment due, GDG may suspend or cease performance of any service until any arrears in payment are brought current. If such arrears are not brought current GDG shall be entitled to recover from the Client a dollar amount equal to the dollar value of any shares or cash due. If the Company wishes to discontinue services that are included in a payment schedule or plan, it may do so with 15 calendar days written notice, and at that point all services, will stop and the Company will forfeit its right to any unused services.
10. The Presenter represents that it is in compliance with all applicable state and federal laws. The Presenter further represents that any information provided to the Host and the public during a presentation, whether in a video, presentation, or otherwise is accurate and not false and / or misleading.
11. All content produced during the Emerging Growth Conference Presentation (the "Content") is and will remain property of the Emerging Growth Conference and its parent company Global Discovery Group, Inc. Each Presenter will be allowed to embed their respective Content on their website, their social media, in their press releases, as well as distribute the Content to the public.
12. The Emerging Growth Conference Staff plans to be present for all Conferences. However, on rare occasions, if a team member such as our regular host or producer are not available or has an emergency to attend to, we may substitute that staff member during that time.
13. The Presenter acknowledges that any copyrighted material(s) within their presentation including but not limited to images, songs, logos, etc. will play for the audience during the Conference, but may be edited out of final video Content when posted to YouTube as per YouTube's terms and conditions.
14. The Presenter shall protect, defend, indemnify and hold Host and its assigns and attorneys, accountants, employees, officers and director harmless from and against all losses, liabilities, damages, judgments, claims, counterclaims, demands, actions, proceedings, costs and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) of every kind and character resulting from, relating to or arising out of (i) the inaccuracy, non-fulfillment or breach of any presentation, or representation, by the Presenter, or (ii) negligent or willful misconduct, occurring during the Presenter's Presentation or (iii) a violation of state or federal securities laws. Furthermore, GDG does not guarantee the results or effectiveness of any of the services rendered or to be rendered by GDG.
15. Any waiver by either party or a breach of any provision of these terms by the other party shall not operate or be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach by any party.
16. The rights granted to the Presenter of the use of the Emerging Growth Conference Platform and Content and obligations of GDG hereunder shall not be assignable without the written consent of both GDG and Presenter.
17. "The World's Largest Virtual Investor Conference" or any similar language is only a tagline as there is no way for us to know the size of, or even the existence of every virtual investor conference in the world.
18. Any action brought by any party will be governed by the laws of and domiciled in the state of Florida. It is the intention of the parties hereto that these terms and conditions, and the performance of such hereunder, and all suits and special proceedings hereunder be construed in accordance with and under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, and that in any action, special proceeding or other proceedings that may be brought arising out of, in connection with or by reason of these terms, the law of the State of Florida shall be applicable and shall govern to the exclusion of the law of any other forum, without regard to the jurisdiction on which any action or special proceeding may be initiated or instituted. Any controversy or claim shall be settled by arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association under its Commercial Arbitration Rules, and judgment on the award rendered by the arbitrator(s) may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof. The arbitration shall be conducted in Miami-Dade County, Florida.
19. All terms and covenants contained herein are severable, and in the event any of them shall be held to be invalid by any competent court, the Terms shall be interpreted as if such invalid terms or conditions were not contained herein.
20. GDG reserves the right to amend these Terms without notice and will keep a current version on <https://emerginggrowth.com/conference-terms-and-conditions/>
21. These terms constitute and embody the entire understanding of the parties and supersedes and replaces all other or prior understandings, agreements, and negotiations between the parties. If there is a conflict between this document and any other document, agreement, or understanding, between the parties, or agents of the parties, this document will prevail.
22. Any waiver, alteration, or modification of any of the provisions of these terms shall be valid only if made in writing and signed by the parties hereto. Each party hereto, may waive any of its rights hereunder without affecting a waiver with respect to any subsequent occurrences or transactions hereof.
